






Painting the Music

Make

- 1. Set up your art materials.
- 2. Choose some music to inspire your painting. Have a listen.
- 3. Think about how the music makes you feel, or what it might look like.
- 4. Have a go at painting what you feel after listening to the music. You might be inspired by the beat or the rhythm, or the mood and melody of the song.
