ELEMENTS of MUSIC

TIMBRE

The different types sounds made by instruments.

It is caused by the different materials instruments are made of, and the way they are played.

RHYTHM

The mix of long and short sounds put together.

Rhythm includes the **length of sound**, **silence**, **beat**, and **tempo**.

PITCH

The height of the sound.

The sounds can be **high** or **low**.

DYNAMICS

The volume of sound you can hear.

Pianissimo (pp) = very soft

Piano (p) = soft

Forte (f) = loud

Fortissimo (ff) = very loud

TEXTURE

The layers of sound.

The music can be thin or thick.

Monophonic = one layer of melody

Polyphonic = two or more layers

Homophonic = melody with accompaniment

FORM

The structure of sections in music.

Examples include ternary form, ostinato, canon, or call and response.
