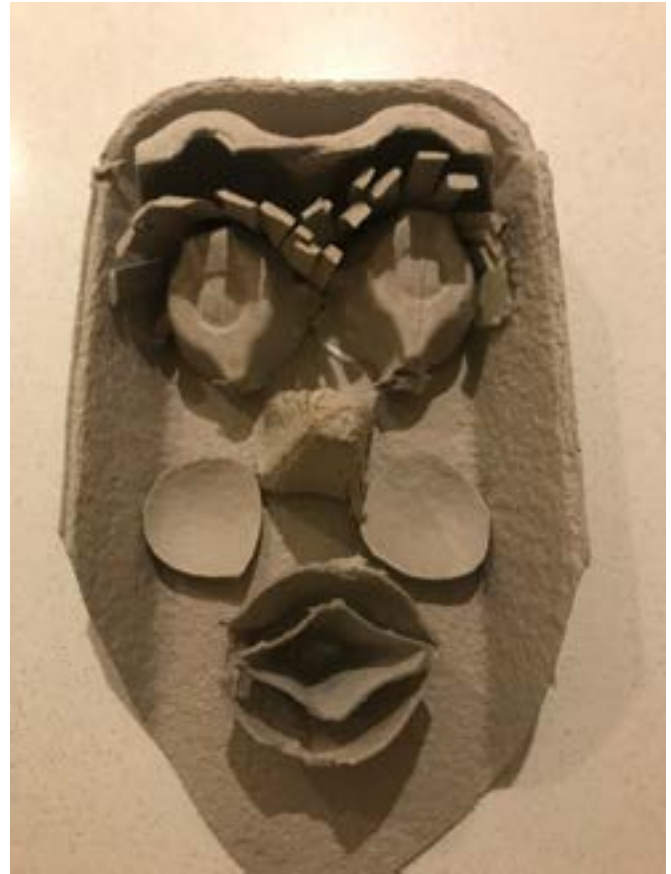
## MAKE

### 1. Make the face

Cut a face shape from the lid of the egg carton.

### 2. Make pieces for the face

Cut the pieces of the face including: eyes, ears, mouth, nose, cheeks, eye brows, eye lashes, chin etc.

Paint or colour the pieces with acrylic paint, markers or food dye.

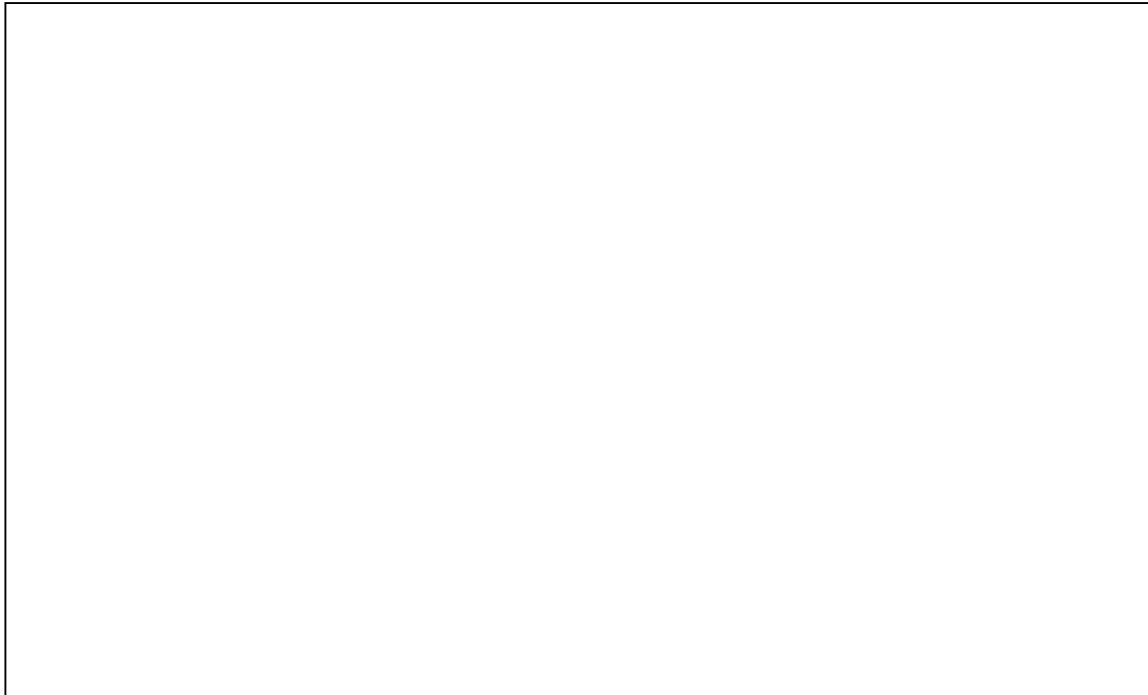
